4. **Alleged Planning Breaches: Loxton Hill Farm:**
 - Works planned or already undertaken to the Public Bridleway and formation of new Access points, including tarmacking part of the bridleway.
 - Use of agricultural land for the storage of non-agricultural caravans and vehicles which appear to be used for residential purposes.
 - Advertised Wild Camping Site operating (from 3rd April) and alleged planning of Music festivals at the location. This is Agricultural Land alongside the West Mendip Way and within the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty
 - To establish whether planning applications or change-of-use permissions have been submitted for any of the above, and whether any of the activities rely on permitted development rights.
 - To consider and agree a response to NSC Planning /Enforcement requesting that the above potential breaches be investigated and that any current works cease while an investigation is carried out.
